Executive Committee

- ◆ 6 elected members (Secretary, Treasurer)
- ◆ Daily business
- ◆ Ensures communication
- ◆ Compiles yearly activities and plans report
- ◆ Maintains central YPP website
- ◆ Seeks and dispenses funding
- ◆ Proposes budget

Elects

Representative Body

- ◆ One representative from each local chapter
- ◆ Elects own Chairperson
- ◆ Elects Executive Committee from among RP members
- ◆ Admits new chapters to YPP
- ◆ Recognizes working groups
- ◆ Amends bylaws
- ◆ Approves budget

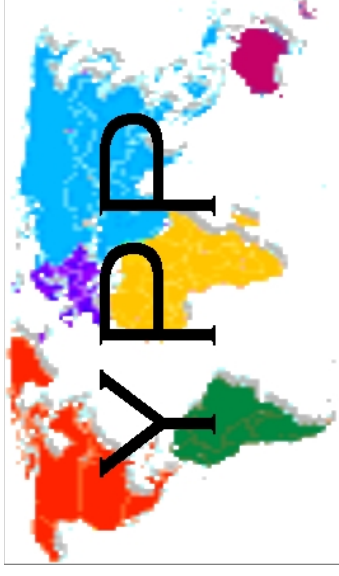

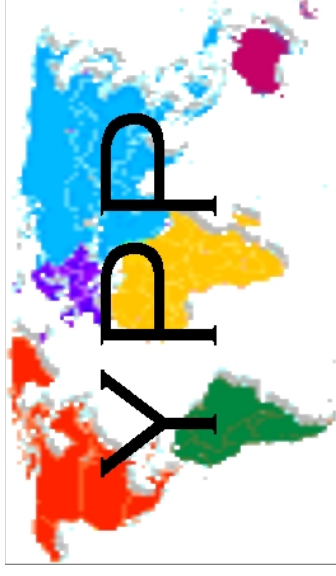
